

Tuberculosis (TB)

Tuberculosis is a bacterial infection primarily affecting the lungs. It spreads through airborne droplets from infected individuals. TB can be severe if untreated, leading to complications such as lung damage or death. Vaccination, particularly with the BCG vaccine, provides crucial protection against severe forms of TB in children.





Whooping Cough (Pertussis)

Whooping cough is a highly contagious respiratory disease characterized by severe coughing fits. It is especially dangerous for infants and young children. The DTP vaccine (Diphtheria, Tetanus, Pertussis) helps protect against this infection and reduces the spread of the disease in communities.


Poliomyelitis (Polio)



Tetanus

Tetanus is a serious bacterial infection that enters the body through wounds or cuts, leading to muscle stiffness, spasms, and potentially death if untreated. The tetanus vaccine is part of routine immunizations and offers critical protection, especially after injuries.





Hepatitis B

Hepatitis B is a viral infection that affects the liver, leading to both acute and chronic liver disease. It can be transmitted through contact with blood or bodily fluids. Vaccination against hepatitis B is highly effective in preventing both infection and its longterm complications like liver cirrhosis and cancer.




